For this arrangement, I wanted a big band in full swing, because this song deserves to celebrate. It's fun, yes, but it also carries a truth only experience can teach: happiness doesn't always arrive when you expect it.

I also see it as a tribute to lowering your guard, letting yourself be surprised, and staying open to wherever life might take you.

Last but not least, this song's call to action is a warm, playful nudge on how to live: having received the best thing that ever has happened, all one can do is be the best thing that ever has happened to others.
